






Three Year Trend: 3-8 ELA District Aggregate Levels of Performance






Three Year Trend: ELA Percent Proficient Results Grades 3-8






Three Year Trend: 3-8 Math District Aggregate Levels of Performance






Three Year Trend: Math Percent Proficient Results Grades 3-8


