RE:	COVID-19 Guidance and Paid Leave Update
DATE:	April 18, 2024

TO:	District Employees

In March, <u>CDC</u> and <u>NYS Department of Health</u> issued guidance updating recommendations for COVID-19, as well as other common respiratory viruses such as flu and RSV. Recommendations for staying home and returning to normal activities are now based on an individual's symptoms rather than a specific isolation period.

Consistent with the updated guidance, if you test positive for COVID-19 or another respiratory virus but <u>do not have symptoms</u>, you may report to work.

If you are <u>experiencing respiratory virus symptoms</u> (e.g. fever, chills, fatigue, cough, runny nose, headache) it is recommended that you stay home and away from others, and only resume normal activities when, for at least 24 hours, <u>both</u> of the following are true:

- 1. Your symptoms are improving, meaning you are starting to feel better overall, and
- 2. You are fever free without needing fever-reducing medication.

Beginning Monday April 29, 2024, the following updated procedures will apply to request NYS COVID-19 Paid Sick Leave:

- Follow regular absence notification processes and sick leave/PTO entry each day you are absent due to symptoms of COVID-19 (leave accruals will be reimbursed if you receive paid COVID-19 leave);
- 2. Obtain a laboratory test or documentation from a licensed medical provider attesting that you tested positive for COVID-19 (note: home tests will not be accepted);
- Complete the "NYS COVID-19 Paid Slck Leave Form effective 4.29.24" available on the <u>HR webpage</u>; and
- 4. Upon your return to work, email documentation of your positive test and your completed form to human_resources@ktufsd.org.

Please note that state guidance continues to limit NYS COVID-19 Paid Sick Leave to <u>three</u> instances.
