- Prior Knowledge of a change in dismissal method or early pick-up:
 - The student brings a note to the **Attendance Office**
- Change in dismissal without prior notice/special circumstances for pick-up/dismissal
 - Email the Attendance Office between 8:00 am and 1 pm at hoover_middle_attendance@ktufsd.org
 - Call the Attendance Office after 1 pm in emergency circumstances ONLY
 - 716-874-8405 press 1 for attendance
- A student is not feeling well and wants to call home:
 - Student reports to the Nurse's Office
 - The Nurse's office staff will contact the parent/guardians for pick-up arrangements
 - Students are not permitted to use a cell phone during school hours unless approved by a teacher, nurse, or administrator.
