Course Cancellations

In the event of course cancellation, patrons will be notified via email at least three (3) business days before the start date and full credits/refunds will be issued in the event the Department cancels a course you are enrolled in. If original payment method was check, a check refund will be processed. For payment by credit card, a refund will be issued to your original payment method if within 120 days. If after 120 days then a check refund will be issued.

Patrons have the option to receive a full credit to use towards a future registration in place of a refund. Credits must be used within one year. Check payments will be refunded via check. **After the start of class, refunds/credits will not be given regardless of reason.**

5 Hour Pre-Licensing Course

Age 16 & up with a valid NYS Learner's Permit by DATE OF CLASS. The pre-licensing course, also known as "the 5-hour classroom course," is a DMV-designed course that provides new drivers with information to help them drive safely. New drivers must complete this course (or a New York State approved Driver Education Course) before they can schedule a driving test for their drivers license. For many students, the course is the only formal opportunity to learn the basic rules of the road, safe driving principles, defensive driving skills, and other factors which affect driving. Completion of this NYS required course will qualify you for the MV-278 Certificate which you need in order to sign up for a road test.
