

If approved, this project will be funded primarily through New York State Education Department Building Aid, with additional funding from the district's capital reserve. The Capital Project encompasses the following proposed priorities and investments at Kenmore West High School:

- Renovations and upgrades to the 80-year-old small gymnasium •
- New student pick-up/drop-off zone to enhance safety during arrival/dismissal
- A Door #1 entrance addition for a more secured Single Point of • Entrv
- Replacement of drinking water pipes to maximize water quality •
- New carbon monoxide detection system •
- Partial roof replacement

for SPOE

- Reconstruction of parking lots and sidewalks
- New single-occupant unisex restrooms •

Note: Construction of artificial turf athletic fields at Kenmore East High School will free up the Kenmore West High School fields for Kenmore West use only (the fields are currently shared between schools)
