


## **Student Enrollment & Demographics Trends**













2012-2013 through 2023-2024 School Years




### **Total Pre-K - Grade 12 Students Residing In District**

As of February 1, of each of these years




### **Total (In-District) Pre-K - Grade 12 Students**

As of February 1, of each of these years




# Snapshot Comparison of Year over Year Trends Total PreK – Grade 12 Resident Students








## SSEC (State Reported Incidents) Leading to OSS

#### School Safety and Educational Climate Data Reported by Schools Grades K-12





- The overarching goal of ESSA is to provide all students with opportunities to receive a fair, equitable, and high-quality education, regardless of zip code

- Absent 10% or more of days enrolled - For students enrolled in Gr. 1 - 12







## NYS ELA and Math 3-8 Assessment Participation Results



New York State Grades 3-8 ELA and Mathematics Computer-Based Testing











#### What Does It Mean to Be TSI?

# Schools in TSI are required to engage in the following:

- Conduct annual spring surveys of students, families, and staff
- Complete\* an internal five-part Needs Assessment
- Write\* an annual improvement plan (known as School Comprehensive Education Plan, or SCEP) approved by the District
- Implement\* and monitor\* the SCEP



\* These activities are completed by a school-based improvement planning team that represents a range of stakeholders
