Restrictions regarding the eligibility for interscholastic sports:

Under New York State Public High School Athletic Association (NYSPHSAA) rules, all students in grades 7-12 will have the opportunity to express interest in attempting to become candidates for our interscholastic teams.

However, to be considered each student must meet several academic, medical, residential, and behavioral standards. In addition, a transfer to another high school, even within the same district, without an appropriate change of residence will be subject to the NYSPHSAA Transfer Rule. This includes requests for Open Enrollment in the Kenmore-Town of Tonawanda Union Free School District.

Students who accept an Open Enrollment opportunity at a high school located outside their residential area (including a transfer from Kenmore East to Kenmore West or vice versa) may be ineligible for **one year** from any sport they competed in at their previous school. Speaking with the Director of Physical Education, Health and Athletics (Brett Banker, 871-3082) is strongly encouraged so that you can make an informed decision prior to any change in registration.
